## 2.) Delivery specification for board and paper

Pallet height:	up to a format of 740 x 1040 mm = maximum 1.45 m incl. pallet starting at format of 741 x 1041 mm = maximum 1.37 m incl. pallet Please note deviating details of the individual order.
Pallet weight:	maximum 1,500 kg
Pallet version:	New dry one-way pallets, non-stop compatible, entry breadth with a min. of 530 mm on the open side. Pallet must have exact size of carton format. No double pallets, no crosspieces on the open side. No two stacks on one pallet.
	<ol> <li>No cross supports</li> <li>Minimum height of pallet grating in machine direction 18 mm</li> <li>Spaces between the pallet grids at least 30 mm</li> <li>Maximum width of the individual slats 100 mm</li> <li>Pallet runners in machine running direction up to 690 mm without Intermediate foot and from 691 mm with intermediate foot</li> <li>Minimum height of pallet blocks 105 mm</li> <li>Between the pallet grate and the substrate, there must be a separating foil</li> </ol>
Pallet flag:	Each pallet flag must contain the following information: Description, "type, quality", format, running direction and grammage of the material, net weight in kg per pallet, gross weight in kg per pallet, pallet no., job no. or Vendor no. of the supplier, reel no. (charge), order no., material no.
	Positioning: Long side and front side below the stretch film.
Rest pallets:	Only one rest pallet per specification
Delivery condition:	Absolute flatness, exact stacking, no contamination.
General:	Grained goods are not permitted.



## 3.) Delivery specification for corrugated board and corrugated packaging

Pallet height:	1.80 m incl. pallet Please note deviating details of the individual order.
Stacking:	Applies to corrugated sheets only: From a quantity of 1,000 sheets and dimensions greater than 600 x 800 mm, only one stack may be placed in the middle of the pallet with as precise an edge as possible. Under a quantity of 1,000 sheets, two piles can be placed in the middle of the pallet.
Pallet overhangs:	Only valid for corrugated cardboard packaging: If there are several stacks per pallet, the maximum overhang is a basic stacking dimension of 900 x 1,300 mm permitted.
Pallet version:	dry, clean Euro Pallet (800 x 1,200 mm) or industrial pallet (1,000 x 1,200 mm)
Pallet flag:	Each pallet flag must contain the following information: Description: Grade and quality composition, format, net weight in kg per pallet, gross weight in kg per pallet, pallet number, job number or Vendor no. of the supplier, order number, material number.
	Positioning: Long side and front side below the stretch film.
Rest pallets:	Only one rest pallet per specification
Delivery condition:	Absolute flatness, exact stacking, no contamination. Open flute sheets must be stacked with the flute pointing upwards. Sheets must not be set down crosswise. There must be a cover (flute) between the pallet and the delivered sheets or outer cases to protect against dirt. The covering has to be done with two boards, which are bound with plastic straps. The minimum size of the boards should be 800 or 1,000 mm, depending on the basic size of the pallet used (Euro or industrial pallet). If the size of the goods is larger than the basic size of the pallet , the boards has to be 20 mm longer than the goods. Open flute hast o be streched in plastic foil in the month of october to march.
